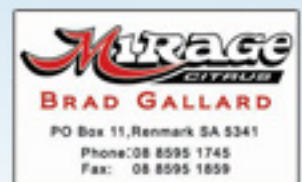

**1. TITLE OF EVENT**

The event shall be known as the Hi-Tec Oils Riverland 300 herein after referred to as "The Event", shall be held under the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport [CAMS], the Off Road Standing Regulations, the SAORRA Multi Club Series Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any further regulations that may be issued. This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies which can be found on the CAMS website at [www.cams.com.au](http://www.cams.com.au) Insurance for this event will be provided in accordance with Appendix I of the current CAMS Manual.

**5. THE EVENT**

The course is situated at Murbko approx. 17 kms west of Waikerie. Scrutiny will take place on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> July at Waikerie Oval and racing will take place on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> July. SA Championship competitors to complete 4 laps of approx. 80 km course and Multi Club competitors to complete 3 laps of approx.80 km course being 75% of State Championship course.

a) **STARTING ORDER:** Starting order for the race will be determined by a Prologue on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> July 2011

**PROLOGUE:** The prologue will be one lap of a 6 km (approx). course.  
Vehicles will line up in random order for prologue .  
Prologue starting intervals will be a minimum of one minute.

Competitors who do not finish the prologue will be given a start position at the rear of the field in front of those who do not start the prologue

Following prologue & Promotional Rides a Top Ten Shootout will take place over a 2.5km track. These results will have no bearing on prologue results.

**RACE:** The track will consist of sand (some sand sections will be EXTREMELY difficult for unmodified cars), limestone and open paddocks and will be approx. 80 kms long.

The event will consist of a total of 2 sections made up of 4 laps state and 3 laps multi club only section.

**There will be a one hour compulsory break to be taken at the completion of any lap but before commencement of final lap (lap four for state section and lap three for multi club only section) and can not be taken part way through a lap.**

Vehicles will start the race 2 cars at a time at 30 second intervals.

Actual Race Time allowed for each vehicle will be advised at crew briefing.

**Other than for event scheduled times the track is private property and no one is permitted to be on it.**

b) **TIMING** will be done by computer to the nearest 100<sup>th</sup> of a second with handheld stop watch back up. The winner will be determined by the shortest total elapsed time.

**7. ENTRIES, CANCELLATION, WITHDRAWALS AND REFUSALS**

**Entries:** A minimum of 25 entries and a maximum of 100 entries will apply to the event. Entries will be determined in order of receipt

**Cancellation:** The organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon, postpone, or modify (subject to Stewards approval) the event (in accordance with NCR 59) in any way in case of unforeseen circumstances, force majeure, or if there is less than 25 with priority notification given to "Paid Competitors" only.

**Withdrawals:** will be accepted on or before 7<sup>th</sup> July 2011 in which case entry fees will be refunded in full after the next Club meeting.

**Refusals:** Entries may be refused in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual.

## 9. COMPETITORS

Where the driver of an automobile is less than 18 years old and does not hold a current civil driver's licence, they must be accompanied at all times while competing by a crew member, in the vehicle, who either holds a current civil driver's licence or is not less than 18 years old. All competitors must hold a current CAMS NO/NON licence and be a financial member of a CAMS affiliated club

## 10. COMPETITOR ELIGIBILITY

The event is open to all off road clubs, however to be eligible for SAORRA Multi Club Trophy Series points you must be a financial member of one of the clubs listed below.

## 11. SCRUTINY

In order to have your vehicle scrutineered, please take the following to event Headquarters ( Waikerie Oval) at the times specified in "Time Schedule" of these Supplementary Regulations.

Racing apparel (which complies with Schedule D of the CAMS Manual)

**UHF Radios will be checked at scrutineering to ensure they are in working order**

Log books will be held by the Chief Scrutineer until after that vehicle has stopped/finished racing. If you DNF without rollover/accident damage to your vehicle it does not require re-scrutiny. If you forget to collect your log book it will be returned to the CAMS office

## 12. RECONNAISSANCE

Competitors will be able to reconnoitre the track commencing at 8.30 a.m. on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> July 2011.

If you are not lined up and in your vehicle ready to go by 8.30 a.m. you will not be able to reconnoitre. Competitors will only be able to reconnoitre the course in road registered 4WD vehicles. **NO VEHICLES PERMITTED TO START ONCE SWEEP VEHICLE HAS LEFT.**

Reconnaissance is to be undertaken at non-competitive speed

## 13. SIGNALLING TO COMPETITORS

Prologue and Race to be started by green Flag. Flags to be used during the event will be as per CAMS manual. Chequered flag will signal end of event.

## 14. SAFETY

- I. Mufflers are to be fitted to all vehicles. Turbo chargers are not considered to be a muffler. Maximum noise emission permitted is 95dba. i.e.; **NO MUFFLER, NO START**
- II. First Aid Marker (green cross on white background) to be affixed on external surface of vehicle adjacent to location of First Aid Kit.
- III. Contrasting front number – Vehicles are required to have a forward facing number of contrasting colour 50 mm high on forward facing surface of vehicle (i.e.; windscreen or sunvisor)
- IV. Personal Ambulance Cover is compulsory for all competitors
- V. Forward Facing Headlamps – Vehicles must be fitted with a minimum of two (2) white, (or equivalent LED) forward facing Headlamps which must be operational at the start of competition. At least one forward facing headlamp shall be operational at the start of each subsequent section.
- VI. All other safety items refer CAMS Manual.
- VII. You are advised to check the CAMS website [www.cams.com.au](http://www.cams.com.au) for any further bulletins and updates

## 15. REFUELLING

Refuelling can only be carried out in the pits or refuelling lane provided. The fuel filler cap/s of the vehicle and the caps/cover/plug of all refuelling containers must remain securely in place until all occupants have vacated the vehicle and the engine switched off. Refuelling on track will be at the Clerk of the Courses discretion. All refuelling must be carried out with a minimum 0.9kg fire extinguisher present as per the Off Road Standing regulations 4.6 (ii) refuelling. Fuel shall be in accordance with schedule G of the current CAMS Manual.

## 16. MEDICAL

Will be carried out by St John personnel and vehicle will be in attendance.

## 17. PENALTIES

Consumption of alcohol or illegal drugs by competitors or crew members during or no less than 10 hours prior to the start of the event ..... up to and including Exclusion  
Dangerous Driving ..... up to and including Exclusion  
Short Cutting the course ..... up to and including Exclusion  
Crew failing to attend drivers briefing ..... may be referred to Stewards  
Plus any penalties imposed by the Event Director and or Stewards of this meeting.

### Use of prohibited Substances

During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s).

### Other Prohibited Substances

The CAMS Anti Doping Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and as amended from time to time, is recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such.

In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the CAMS Anti Doping Policy conflict, the CAMS Anti Doping Policy will take precedence.

## 18. AWARDS & TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> outright driver and navigator and 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in class for driver and navigator depending on the number of entries in each class. 6 or more entries 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5 entries 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3 or less 1<sup>st</sup> only. Any other trophies will be announced at drivers briefing.

### SAORC Points-SAORRA Multi Club Series Points:

Points will be awarded for SA Off Road Championship, SAORRA Driver of the year and Multi Club Series

### SA Off Road Championship points will be awarded as follows:

Outright winners will be determined by the highest points overall, calculated by the combined totals of class and outright points from each event. Class winners are also determined by the same formula.

SAORRA Driver of the year and Multi Club Series points are only awarded to clubs affiliated with SAORRA and are the same as SAORC points.

The S.A.Off Road Championship will consist of 4 rounds – Round 1Baroota, Round 2 Waikerie, Round 3 Naracoorte, Round 4 Pines. Points from all rounds count.

The SAORRA Multi Club Series is conducted over 6 rounds with the highest point scorer overall to be deemed the winner.

### Points shall be allocated to drivers and navigators of the first 10 cars in each class as follows:

**Share Drivers or Navigators:** If two or more drivers share a car then points will be shared equally between drivers. If two or more navigators share a car then points will be shared equally between navigators. If either of the aforementioned happens, this must be notified to the Event Officials either via the entry form or personally before the event starts. In an emergency where an additional navigator is required **during** the race, this must be notified to the Event Secretary before the person enters the car, that person must be entered in the event on an entry form of another competitor. The reason for this is two fold, both for CAMS insurance and for the S.A. Championship points allocation. There will be no points gained by drivers and navigators in the event prologue. Any navigators who travel in two or more cars at an Event, must notify, **prior** to the Event start, in which car they wish to accumulate points. Their presence in the other car(s) will be ignored. Also any navigator who is named on the entry form **must** compete in the Event to gain points.

Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual.

## 19. RETURNING TO THE PITS

Returning to pits to effect repairs to vehicles other than via the Pit Entry gates from the track will only be allowed when:

- Being towed by recovery vehicle.
- Being escorted by recovery vehicle
- Via designated access road/s.

YOU MAY REJOIN RACE FROM PIT EXIT ONLY and will have to re-run the lap you came in on or second section of the track depending on which pit entry you came in on. Time for this lap will include unfinished lap and repair time. Further explanation at Crew briefing.
